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4 <u>ENROLLED</u>, An Act,

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5 To make an appropriation of \$38,460,473 from the 6 Children First Trust Fund for the fiscal year ending September 7 30, 2019, to the entities and for the purposes designated in 8 Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of Alabama 1975; to provide for the 9 deposit of tobacco settlement revenues into the Children First 10 Trust Fund; to require written notification of anticipated 11 agency allocations by the State Director of Finance; to 12 require quarterly allocations; to condition allocations on 13 receipt of tobacco revenues; to provide for the transfer to 14 the State General Fund during fiscal year 2019 that portion of 15 Children First Trust Fund receipts currently allocated for the 16 State Board of Education; to make an appropriation of 17 \$47,788,069 from other tobacco settlement funds for the fiscal 18 year ending September 30, 2019; and to make a conditional 19 appropriation and allocation of additional tobacco revenues 20 upon the recommendation of the Director of Finance, the 21 Chairman of the House Ways and Means General Fund Committee 22 and the Chairman of the Senate Finance and Taxation-General 23 Fund Committee, and the approval of the Governor. 24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. (a) There is hereby appropriated from the Children First Trust Fund the sum of \$38,460,473 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, to the entities and for the purposes designated in Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of Alabama 1975 as follows, per the approved plan of investment for each agency:

(b) (1) All tobacco revenues from the tobacco
settlement received by the state previously designated for the
Children First Trust Fund shall be deposited to the Children

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First Trust Fund within 30 calendar days of receipt of those
 tobacco revenues.

3 (2) The Director of Finance shall notify each agency
4 and the Department of Children's Affairs in writing prior to
5 September 1, 2018, of the dollar amount of the allocation
6 expected to be received by the agency from the Children First
7 Trust Fund in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

8 (3) At the beginning of each quarter of the fiscal 9 year ending September 30, 2019, the respective agency shall be allocated at least one-fourth of the total amount appropriated 10 11 and allocated to the agency for that fiscal year when tobacco 12 revenues are available for the respective agency. In the event 13 tobacco revenues are not available for the respective agency 14 until later in the fiscal year then the respective agency 15 shall be allocated an equal quarterly allotment for the 16 quarters that funds are available at the beginning of those 17 quarters. Such allocation shall be made and be available for 18 expenditure by the agency within five working days of the 19 commencement of the quarter. If additional sums are 20 appropriated or allocated, or both, during the fiscal year, 21 these sums shall be equally allocated to the respective agency 22 among the remaining quarters of the fiscal year or may be allocated to the respective agency in one sum if revenues are 23 24 available. The Department of Early Childhood Education shall

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1 be notified in writing of all appropriations and allocations from the Children First Trust Fund by the Director of Finance. 2 3 (4) Allocations from the Children First Trust Fund 4 are conditioned upon the receipt of tobacco revenues. 5 (c) Allocations received pursuant to Section 1 shall 6 be expended in accordance with Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of 7 Alabama 1975. 8 (d) At the conclusion of the fiscal year, any 9 remaining sums in the Children First Trust Fund shall remain 10 in the fund and shall not revert to the General Fund or to any 11 other fund. 12 Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of Division 13 1 of Article 17 of Chapter 10 of Title 41, Code of Alabama 14 1975, any provision of Chapter 15B of Title 41, Code of 15 Alabama 1975, or any other provision of law, that portion of 16 Children First Trust Fund receipts currently allocated for the 17 State Board of Education shall be transferred from the Children First Trust Fund to the State General Fund during the 18 19 fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

20 Section 3. In addition to the appropriation herein 21 above made, there is hereby appropriated from additional to-22 bacco settlement funds the sum of \$47,788,069 for the fiscal 23 year ending September 30, 2019 to the following entities:

6 Section 4. Any additional tobacco revenues available 7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, shall be 8 conditionally appropriated, conditioned upon the 9 recommendation of the Director of Finance, the Chairman of the 10 House Ways and Means General Fund Committee and the Chairman 11 of the Senate Finance and Taxation-General Fund Committee, and 12 approval of the Governor.

13 Section 5. The Executive Budget Office and the 14 Director of Finance shall allot funds appropriated from the Children First Trust Fund only following the certification by 15 16 the Commissioner of the Department of Early Childhood 17 Education that a plan of investment has been approved for each 18 agency. The Commissioner of the Department of Early Childhood 19 Education shall prescribe the form and format on which each 20 agency receiving appropriated funds herein shall submit a plan 21 of investment of said appropriated funds. The plan of 22 investment shall include, but not be limited to, a minimum of 23 four (4) quality assurance items on which a periodic report,

1 as required by the approved plan of investment, is made and as 2 audited by the Examiners of Public Accounts. Quality assurance 3 items shall include the number of children receiving service, an identifiable measure of success of services provided and a 4 5 prioritized standard of successful measures for future plans of investment. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 6 7 Commissioner of the Department of Early Childhood Education 8 shall be responsible for providing a standard of measurement 9 by which a clear determination can be made through operational 10 reporting and audit reporting of a measurable success of funds 11 appropriated and invested from the Children First Trust Fund; 12 insure funds appropriated herein are invested in viable 13 programs; insure and promote the leverage of appropriated 14 funds herein in every possible manner and coordinated in all 15 possible ways the investment of funds by each service provider 16 to insure that no unproductive expenditures or duplication 17 occurs. The Commissioner of the Department of Early Childhood 18 Education shall notify legislators representing the area where a grant from the Children First Trust Fund is designated. The 19 20 notification shall occur ten days before the funds reach the 21 recipient agency.

22 Section 6. The Commissioner of the Department of 23 Early Childhood Education shall report each approved plan of 24 investment to the Joint Interim Legislative Oversight 25 Committee and the Alabama Children's Policy Council. The

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1 Commissioner, upon the request of the service agency, may 2 approve an adjusted plan of investment. It is the intent of 3 the Legislature that funds appropriated from the Children 4 First Trust Fund be directed to meet the most immediate needs 5 of children as changing conditions may develop. 6 Section 7. Should any provision of this act be held 7 invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining 8 provisions of the act. 9 Section 8. This act shall become effective

10 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 11 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
