The Good Roots grant program, in partnership with the Alabama Urban Forestry Association and Alabama Forestry Commission, supplies up to \$1,000 per grant to purchase trees for planting in cities, towns and communities, and at properties owned by nonprofit organizations across the state.

Good Roots grants are available to local governments (cities, towns, communities of any size, educational institutions) or city and county school systems, universities and any 501(c)(3) organization.

## POWER TO PLAY GRANTS

Power to Play grants provide support and increase participation in athletics and arts programs for both middle and high schools. This year, grant funding may be used to help replenish revenue lost due to COVID-19-related restrictions such as loss of ticket sales and concession stand sales.
